Re: Funding Opportunities for Disaster Resiliency Projects

## Colleagues:

This is the only federal funding opportunity I have found so far this week and you have seen it in my memos before. We will be alternating each week among the five areas of priorities (water, wastewater, disaster resiliency, transportation, and energy efficiency). Be sure to check the subject line for topic area and date each week.

- 1. The USDA Forest Service has a Community Wildfire Defense Grant. This is due on **10/31/23**. Eligibility includes counties, towns, special districts, and non profits other than higher ed. The targets are:
  - The development and revision of Community Wildfire Protection Plans (CWPP)
  - The implementation of projects described in a CWPP that is less than ten years old.
