1. [Climate Pollution Reduction Grants \(CPRG\) Program: Implementation Grants](#), General Competition
  - a. NOFO can be found [here](#).
  - b. “In general, entities eligible to apply for an implementation grant under this announcement are states, municipalities, air pollution control agencies, tribes, territories, and groups thereof. More specifically, states, municipalities, tribes, and territories that directly received a CPRG planning grant are eligible to apply for an implementation grant. In addition, municipalities, air pollution control agencies, and tribes that did not directly receive a planning grant but that seek funding to implement one or more GHG reduction measures that are included in an applicable PCAP are eligible to apply.”
  - c. “Designed to enable states, municipalities, tribes, and territories to achieve the following goals:
    - i. Implement ambitious measures that will achieve significant cumulative GHG reductions by 2030 and beyond;
    - ii. Pursue measures that will achieve substantial community benefits (such as reduction of criteria air pollutants (CAPs) and hazardous air pollutants (HAPs)), particularly in low-income and disadvantaged communities;
    - iii. Complement other funding sources to maximize these GHG reductions and community benefits; and,
    - iv. Pursue innovative policies and programs that are replicable and can be “scaled up” across multiple jurisdictions.”
  - d. The State of Colorado may be applying for this opportunity and it may be good for local governments to coordinate with them. We will share more information when we get it.
