Re: Funding Opportunities for Transportation

Colleagues:

Here are some grant opportunities related to transportation that were not included in past memos. Reach out with any questions any time. Also, **please keep us updated if you are pursuing any federal monies.**

1. Local Government Electric Vehicle Readiness Planning Grants

- a. "CEO will provide funding to local, county, and tribal governments and their regional partners to develop EV readiness plans that will allow communities to establish a shared vision for EV readiness, identify key partnerships and actionable strategies needed to achieve the vision, and prepare for and encourage community adoption of electric vehicles."
- b. Expected to open late October 2023

2. Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE)

- a. "For surface transportation infrastructure projects that will improve: safety; environmental sustainability; quality of life; mobility and community connectivity; economic competitiveness and opportunity including tourism; state of good repair; partnership and collaboration; and innovation."
- b. Expected to open late fall 2023

3. Railroad Crossing Elimination Grant Program

- a. "For highway-rail or pathway-rail grade crossing improvement projects that focus on improving the safety and mobility of people and goods."
- b. Expected to open fall 2023

4. Bridge Investment Program

- a. To reduce the overall number of bridges in poor or fair condition. The bridge must be on the <u>National Bridge Inventory</u>, rated poor or imminently poor, culverts also qualify.
- b. Three categories:
 - i. Planning Project Grant planning, feasibility analyses, revenue forecasting with no award minimum or maximum. **Upcoming**
 - ii. Bridge Project Grants with total eligible project costs of not greater than \$100 million with minimum ward \$2.5 million. **Upcoming**
 - iii. Large Bridge Project with total eligible project costs of greater than \$100 million with minimum award \$50 million. **Due 11/27/23**
