1. [Local Government Electric Vehicle Readiness Planning Grants](#) - *updated information*
  - a. "CEO will provide funding to local, county, and tribal governments and their regional partners to develop EV readiness plans that will allow communities to establish a shared vision for EV readiness, identify key partnerships and actionable strategies needed to achieve the vision, and prepare for and encourage community adoption of electric vehicles."
  - b. "EV readiness plans must be regional in nature, and the development process should ensure engagement with a wide variety of public and private stakeholders."
  - c. **Due 12/15/23**
  
2. [National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure \(NEVI\)](#) - *updated information*
  - a. Colorado Energy Office, via IJJA
  - b. To support buildout of electric vehicle charging stations within 1 mile of federally designated corridors including Hwy 50 and 550.
  - c. *Rural area match = 20% with reductions in match possible in certain circumstances.*
  - d. *There is a partnering list on the website that you can fill out to express interest in installing a charger(s) in your community via partnership with a charging provider. It does not commit your community to anything but exploring potential partnerships. Fill this out ASAP if interested.*

4. [Fueling Aviation's Sustainable Transition \(FAST\)](#)

- a. FAA
- b. “Will make investments to accelerate production and use of sustainable aviation fuels (SAF) and the development of low-emission aviation technologies to support the U.S. aviation climate goal to achieve net zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050.” Two programs:
  - i. Sustainable aviation fuels (FAST-SAF) portion of the program will “support the build out of infrastructure projects related to SAF production, transportation, blending, and storage.”
  - ii. Low-emissions technology (FAST-Tech) will provide funding “to develop and demonstrate new aviation technologies to improve fuel efficiency and reduce emissions.”
