- 1. High Efficiency Electric Heating and Appliance Grant Program
  - a. CO Energy Office
  - b. "To support community efforts to switch to high efficiency electric heat & appliances."
  - c. Due 12/1/2023, may open again if there is funding remains available

## 2. Geothermal Energy Grant Program

- a. CO Energy Office
- b. To "support the use of zero-emission, geothermal energy for electricity generation and space/water heating and cooling in homes, businesses, and communities. The GEGP program portfolio includes three sub-grant areas: Single-Structure Geothermal, Community District Heating/Thermal Energy Network, and Geothermal Electricity Generation."

## 3. Community Change Grants Program

- a. EPA
- b. "To benefit <u>disadvantaged communities</u> through projects that reduce pollution, increase community climate resilience, and build community capacity to address environmental and climate justice challenges. These place-based investments will be focused on community-driven initiatives to be responsive to community and stakeholder input. They are designed to deliver on the transformative potential of the IRA for communities most adversely and disproportionately impacted by climate change, legacy pollution, and historical disinvestments."
- c. A local government must partner with a community-based non-profit organization, additional partners also accepted.



- d. Expect to award a few smaller projects ranging from \$1-3 million, with most projects expected to be from \$10-20 million. Recipients will have 3 years maximum to complete the project.
- e. Technical assistance to apply is available to eligible applicants.

- g. Due no later than 11/21/2024, accepted on a rolling basis
