Re: FEMA BRIC and LOMA Match

Colleagues:

If you are applying for the above through the Colorado Dept. of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, we have this update regarding the use of LOMA matching funds through DOLA. It is good news.

From the State, "As some of you might be aware, BRIC and FMA are a bit different then (sic) other IJA programs we are seeing. We've had a number of conversations about how the program is structured and if local governments are eligible for LOMA and have determined that yes, local governments can apply for LOMA to support their federal matching needs for both of these programs. Both of these programs are running through DHSEM and [Mark Thompson](#) is your contact."

Please remember that letters of intent are due now and the full application is due December 22<sup>nd</sup>. If you do not have a shovel ready project and a current scope, schedule, and budget, I am not certain you can make this deadline. But the link to the NOI process is here.
