Re: Funding Opportunities for Transportation

Colleagues:

Here are a few grant opportunities, one repeat and two updates, related to transportation. These are opportunities that currently open or will open soon. Reach out with any questions any time. Also, **please keep us updated if you are pursuing any federal monies.**

- 1. Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) repeat
 - a. USDOT
 - b. "For surface transportation infrastructure projects that will improve: safety; environmental sustainability; quality of life; mobility and community connectivity; economic competitiveness and opportunity including tourism; state of good repair; partnership and collaboration; and innovation."

 - d. Due 2/28/2024
- 2. Safe Streets for All updated
 - a. USDOT, applications go to FHWA
 - b. Funding for: 1) Planning and demonstration grants to develop, complete, or supplement a comprehensive safety action plan and 2) Implementation grants (to implement a qualifying safety action plan).
 - c. To help understand qualifying projects, see the <u>map of recently funded projects</u>.
 - d. Expected February 2024
- 3. Revitalizing Main Streets updated
 - a. CDOT
 - b. "This grant program is to fund active transportation infrastructure improvements that will support downtown vitality and the built environment, encourage economic development, support community access to public streets and multimodal transportation, and imagine innovative uses of public spaces for people."
 - c. 10% minimum match.
 - d. For shovel ready projects, must be implemented in 12 months.
 - e. Not just for Main Streets but for roads that are used by pedestrians.
 - f. A new application will be available as soon as January 2024.
 - g. Due last Wednesday of every other month, next deadline 2/28/2024
