Here are two opportunities to support fire depts. and local governments.

- The first one supports the conversion of vehicles in to wildland fire engines. It is a pilot program through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law. The deadline is March 21, 2024. Eligible applicants include rural local governments (population of 25,000 or less). For more information, visit DOI's website. This submission must go through Grants.gov.
- The second one is FEMA Assistance to Firefighters which is due March 2, 2024. This program helps firefighters
 and other first responders obtain equipment, protective gear, emergency vehicles, training, and other
 resources for protecting against fire and related hazards. Eligible applicants include fire departments, state
 fire training academies, and emergency medical service organizations. For more information, visit <u>FEMA's</u>
