Re: Funding Opportunities for Transportation

Colleagues:

Here are a few grant opportunities, one *updated* and two new, related to transportation. Reach out with any questions any time. Also, **please keep us updated if you are pursuing any federal monies.**

- 1. Safe Streets for All updated
 - a. USDOT, applications go to FHWA
 - b. "Grants aim to significantly reduce or eliminate roadway fatalities and serious injuries by developing safety action plans implementing projects focused on all users, including pedestrians, bicyclists, public transportation users, motorists, micromobility users, and commercial vehicle operators." There are two categories for funding:
 - i. Planning and demonstration grants to develop, complete, or supplement a comprehensive safety action plan, and
 - ii. Implementation grants (to implement a qualifying safety action plan).
 - c. See the map of recently funded projects.
 - d. Webinars
 - i. 3/7/24: Focuses on applications to develop an Action Plan
 - *ii.* 3/8/24: Focuses on applications for supplemental planning and demonstration activities
 - *iii.* 3/13/24: <u>Focuses on applications for implementation grants</u>
 - e. NOW OPEN, deadlines depend on the application type:
 - *i.* **Planning and Demonstration** applications may be submitted for any of the following deadlines: 4/4/204, 5/16/24, and 8/29/24
 - *ii.* Implementation Grant applications are due 5/16/24, if unsuccessful you may apply for a Planning and Demonstration grant by 8/29/24

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2. Buses and Bus Facilities Program, AKA 5339(b)

- a. FTA
- b. "Makes federal resources available to states and direct recipients to replace, rehabilitate and purchase buses and related equipment and to construct bus-related facilities, including technological changes or innovations to modify low or no emission vehicles or facilities. Funding is provided through formula allocations and competitive grants."
- c. Applications are to be coordinate with CASTA and CDOT:

- 3. Low or No Emission Vehicle Program, AKA Low-No and 5339(c)

 - b. "For the purchase or lease of zero-emission and low-emission transit buses as well as acquisition, construction, and leasing of required supporting facilities."
