1. [Hydroelectric Production Incentives](#)
  - a. DOE
  - b. For those qualified hydroelectric facilities that generated and sold energy in calendar year 2023.
  - c. “Incentive payments to the owners and authorized operators of qualified hydroelectric facilities at existing dams to be used to make capital improvements in the facilities that are directly related to improving the efficiency of such facilities by at least three percent.”
  - d. **Due 4/23/24**
  
2. [Energy Code Adoption and Enforcement Grant program](#)
  - a. CEO
  - b. Supports local governments with adoption, implementation, and enforcement of the latest energy codes or stretch energy codes.
  - c. Note that [HB22-1362](#) established new minimum energy code requirements for local governments that adopt or update any building code.
  - d. **Due 5/31/24**
