Re: Funding Opportunities for Transportation

## Colleagues:

Here is one quick update on a program I just shared with you last week related to transportation. Reach out with any questions any time. Also, **please keep us updated if you are pursuing any federal monies.** 

## 1. Clean Heavy-Duty Vehicles - updated

- a. EPA
- b. "Funding to help Tribal, state, and local governments and other entities offset the cost of replacing heavy-duty Class 6 and 7 commercial vehicles with zero-emission vehicles, deploy supporting infrastructure, and train and develop the necessary workforce. At least \$400 million must go to areas not meeting national air quality standards."
- c. This funding round has up to \$932 million, \$400 million of which must serve communities designated in nonattainment areas by the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). R10 does not include any of these areas as far as I can tell.
- d. Municipalities and nonprofit school transportation associations can apply.
- e. Expect to award 40-160 grants ranging from \$500,000 to \$60 million.
- f. Includes two sub programs:
  - i. School Bus (70% of funding) for replacement of school buses.
  - ii. Vocational Vehicle (30% of funding) replacing non-school bus class 6-7 vehicles.
